Convert a series of images to a movie

- There are several way to do this:
 - Windows XP: use Movie Maker (drag and drop images)
 - Unix/Linux:
 - ffmpeg (no delay per picture)
 - image magick: `convert`

Using: Image Magick

- Available for Windows, Mac, Linux, Unix

```
[user@host] convert -delay 100 *.jpg omega.mpg
```

`-delay` : every picture will be shown for <number>/100 seconds

- Screen record: **kazam**
- Display picture of own webcam (to be recorded simultaneously): **guvview**
- Animate mouse movement, show mouse clicks:
- Audio Control: **pavucontrol**
